#### **Dental Benefits**

Dental benefits are paid at the Scheme Tariff.

Dental benefits are subject to managed care protocols and managed care interventions which may include the requirement of treatment plans and/or radiographs prior to benefit application.

Scheme Exclusions apply to dental benefits.

In the event of a dispute, the registered Rules of the Scheme prevail.

# **Specialised Dentistry**

All Specialised Dentistry benefits for the *Makoti Comprehensive* option are subject to a limit of **R3 537** per family per year. This includes Partial Metal Frame Dentures, Crown & Bridge, Orthodontics, Periodontics and Maxillo-facial Surgery.

#### Pre-authorisation\*

*Makoti Comprehensive* option: Dentures must be preauthorised.

**All options**: Hospitalisation and certain Specialised Dentistry procedures must be pre-authorised.

If no pre-authorisation is obtained or if pre-authorisation is applied for after the treatment has been done, benefits will not apply for Crowns, Periodontics, Moderate/Deep Sedation in Dental Rooms and Hospitalisation.

Failure to pre-authorise orthodontic treatment will result in a payment *only* from date of authorisation for the remaining months of treatment, provided that the treatment is clinically indicated.

Pre-authorisation does not apply to emergency hospital admissions.

# **Out-of-Hospital DSP Network**

Benefits payable on the *Sizwe Hosmed Essential Copper* option is subject to the use of a Designated Service Provider (DSP) on the *DENIS Dental Network*.

### **Hospital DSP Network**

Dental Hospital Admissions are currently *not subject* to a Hospital DSP Network.

Dental Hospital Admissions are managed by *3Sixty Health.* 

#### Pre-authorisation\*

Hospitalisation (*3Sixty Health*) and certain dentistry procedures, namely dentures and Moderate/Deep Sedation in the Dental Rooms (*DENIS*) must be preauthorised.

Procedures and treatments not pre-authorised will not attract a benefit.

Penalties do not apply to emergency hospital admissions.
